IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

1. Read all instructions.
2. This appliance is not intended for use by children or by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they are closely supervised and instructed concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
3. This appliance shall not be used by children. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children.
4. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used near children. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
5. To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not put cord, plug, base, or motor in water or other liquid.
6. Release the activation lever; then unplug from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning. To unplug, grasp the plug and pull from the outlet. Never pull from the power cord.
7. Avoid contacting moving parts.
8. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged supply cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Supply cord replacement and repairs must be conducted by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard. Call the provided customer service number for information on examination, repair, or adjustment.
9. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the appliance manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
10. Do not use outdoors.
11. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces including the stove.
12. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
13. Do not open pressurized (aerosol-type) cans.
14. Do not open cans of flammable liquids such as lighter fluid.
15. Release the activation lever before plugging cord into wall outlet. To disconnect, release the activation lever; then remove plug from wall outlet. To unplug, grasp the plug and pull from the outlet. Never pull from the power cord.
16. Do not use appliance for other than intended purpose.

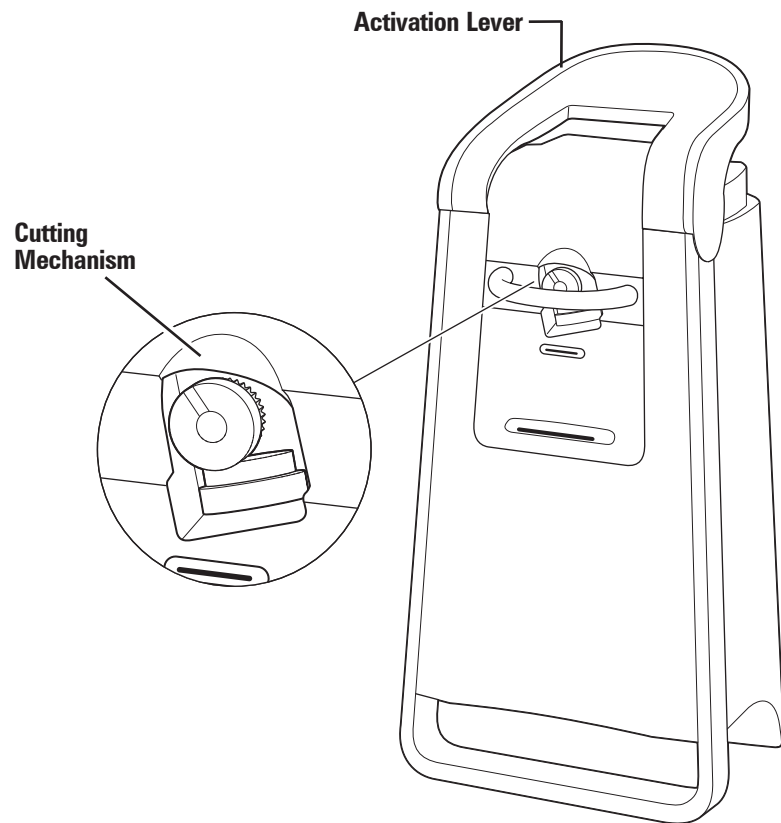
Other Consumer Safety Information

This appliance is intended for household use only.

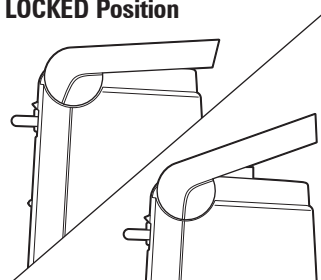
⚠ WARNING Shock Hazard: This appliance has a polarized plug (one wide blade) that reduces the risk of electric shock. The plug fits only one way into a polarized outlet. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the plug by modifying the plug in any way or by using an adapter. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, have an electrician replace the outlet.

The length of the cord used on this appliance was selected to reduce the hazards of becoming tangled in or tripping over a longer cord. If a longer cord is necessary, an approved extension cord may be used. The electrical rating of the extension cord must be equal to or greater than the rating of the appliance. Care must be taken to arrange the extension cord so that it will not drape over the countertop or tabletop where it can be pulled on by children or accidentally tripped over.

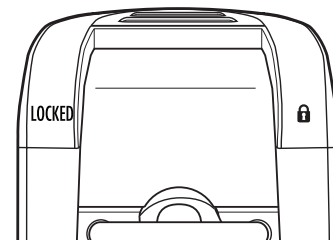


LOCKED Position

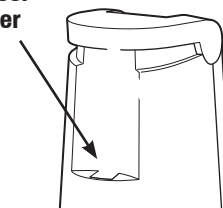


UNLOCKED Position

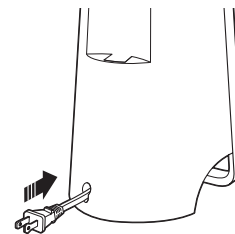
LOCKED Position



Scissor Holder



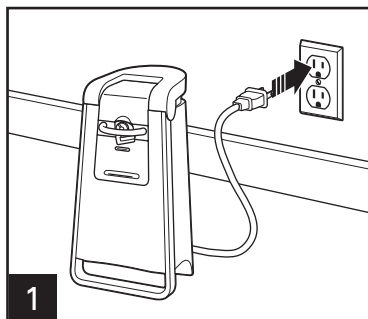

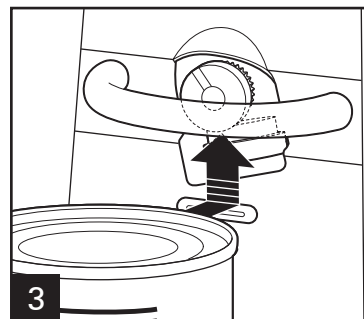
Cord Storage (back of unit).

How to Use

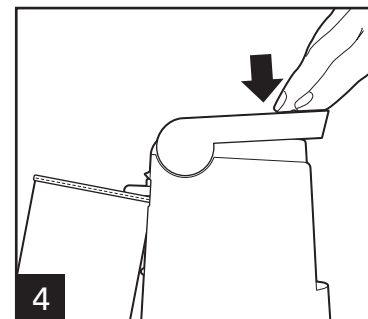
NOTE: This can opener cuts the side around the top of the can.



Make sure the activation lever is pulled all the way **UP** and in the **UNLOCKED** position.



Place can against front of can opener and lift up until rim is under cutting mechanism.



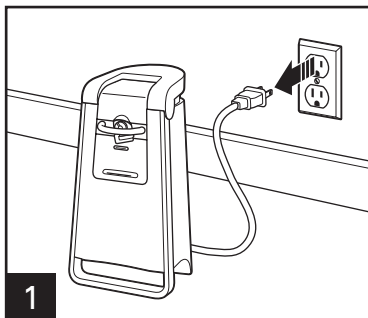
Hold the lever down until the can has completed **ONE ROTATION ONLY**.



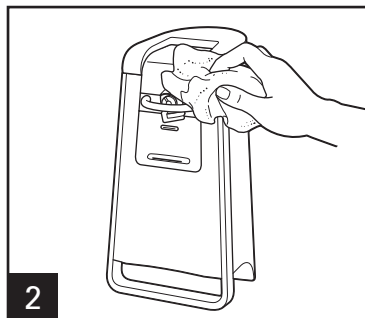
NOTES:

- The motor **WILL NOT** automatically stop or lift the lid when the can has opened.
- Allowing only one rotation reduces or prevents metal slivers.
- When the motor sound shifts to a higher pitch, the can is open. Carefully lift the lid up to remove.
- Can opener has a 24-inch cord. Cord can be stored in the unit by pushing the cord in the small hole on the back of the unit. To pull the cord out, pull up then out.

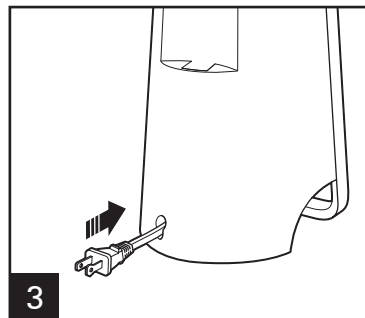
Care and Cleaning



1. Unplug unit.



2. Wipe outside with damp cloth.



3. Store cord in unit by pushing in small hole.

TIPS:

- DO NOT hold the can while the can is being opened.
- Some microwaveable can designs do not work with this can opener.
- The can opener will easily open all standard-size cans and cans with pop-top lids.
- If there is a bump, dent, or heavy seam in the rim of the can, open the other end of the can or start cutter just beyond it.
- The motor of your can opener is permanently lubricated and will require no oiling.
- Cans only need one full rotation to open.
